## CHANGES TO THE RAJAR SURVEY FOR Q1 2010

$1^{\text {st }}$ March 2010

RAJAR is making the following changes to the survey, applicable from the release of the Q1 2010 RAJAR results.

## a) Changes to the Self Completion questionnaire

The RAJAR Board requested a review of the self completion questionnaire that features at the beginning of the RAJAR diary. As a result, some questions have been eliminated while others have been modified. Also, at the request of the BBC, a question on audience representation has been added. This will help the BBC to verify that they are catering for audiences with special needs.

Attached is the summary of the modifications to the questionnaire. Please note that these changes only affect questions that feature on the self completion questionnaire and that the recruitment questionnaire, as administered by the interviewer to collect all demographic information as well as platform ownership and use, has not been altered.
b) Changes to regions

The ISBA regions have been discontinued and they are replaced with non-overlapping ITV regions. These are the same nonoverlapping regions that have been introduced by BARB with their new 2010 contract. We hope this will help with planning cross media campaigns.

## c) New Mosaic and ACORN codes

Mosaic have introduced a new segmentation with the addition of new groups, while ACORN have updated their classification. Along with BARB and the NRS, RAJAR is introducing Mosaic's new segmentation and ACORN's new classification from Q1 2010 and is providing back data for the full year. We hope this data will help users to prepare for this change.
